RESOLVED: That the Trustees of The Metropolitan Museum of Art hereby record their sorrow and deep sense of personal loss at the death on December 20, 2020 of former Honorary Trustee Sheikh Nasser Sabah al-Ahmad al-Sabah.

Sheikh Nasser Sabah al-Ahmad al-Sabah was a longtime friend to The Met and Honorary Trustee from 2003 to 2011. He had a great appreciation for art and was an avid supporter of culture around the world. Sheikh Nasser and his wife, Honorary Trustee Sheikha Husa Sabah al-Salem al-Sabah, have been generous supporters of the Department of Islamic Art, providing funds for a range of initiatives and exhibitions, loaning art from their outstanding al-Sabah collection, and, most recently, endowing a curatorship in the department. Sheikh Nasser leaves behind an enduring legacy of art and humanity, and he will be deeply missed. We send our condolences to Sheikha Husa and their family.
